Originally located in Chelsea, the Pediatric Center moved to a brand new, state-of-the-art facility in Yonkers in 2012 and, just last year, grew with a 32-bed expansion for technology-dependent children. Today, the Pediatric Center is "home" to 169 extraordinary children, which makes us the largest post-acute care provider for this unique population in the entire U.S.

As a nationally recognized leader in pediatric health care with a track record of medical excellence and historic "firsts," the Pediatric

Center plans to soon pioneer the nation's first, free-standing young adult facility, specifically tailored for medically complex adults ages 21 to 35.
